SUMMER READING CHARLESTON DAY SCHOOL

Rising 7th Grade

The reading should be completed throughout the summer and not the last week of August. The main purpose of summer reading is to keep the verbal skills sharp. An added benefit is that summer provides the time to find joy in reading.

REQUIRED READING

The Outsiders by S.E. Hinton

STUDENT CHOICE

Students must read <u>two</u> additional books. One must be from the attached list of classic middle grade literature. The second book can be any book you and your family decide is a good fit. If you want, you may read another classic work, a Newbery Award Winner, A South Carolina Book Award Winner, or anything that is age appropriate. Do <u>not</u> choose books that you have already read, picture books, or graphic novels.

Students should write a total of <u>two</u> book reports, one for each book that they select on their own (not for the required reading selection).

Book Report Guidelines:

- The appropriate length is 1-2 pages double-spaced, using Times New Roman 12-point font and 1 inch margins.
- There should be a minimum of 3 paragraphs of 5-8 complete sentences in each paragraph.
- First paragraph should summarize the setting and describe the main character(s).
- Second/third paragraph should discuss a few critical events in the story that changed the main character, revealed a theme, or represented a conflict. Discuss something you learned while reading. Do NOT simply retell the plot.

Please also include the following information in the upper left-hand corner of each report.

- 1. Your name
- 2. Title, author, and number of pages
- 3. Date completed
- 4. Parent's signature

The reports should be expressed in paragraph form, typed, and printed. The reports are due the first day of school. Your grade will be penalized by a deduction of 10 points every day that the entire assignment is late.

In addition, students will be tested on the required class novel during the first week of school. Again, a report is <u>NOT</u> required for the required selection.
